'সবার উপরে মানুষ সত্য '

এমন এক পৃথিবীতে জন্ম আমরা প্রত্যাশা করি যেখানে পরিচয় একটাই থাকবে, সে পরিচয় কেবলমাত্র মানুষ। জন্মগতভাবে নারী-পুরুষ বিভাজন বৈজ্ঞানিক সত্য। কিন্তু সমাজ তৈরি করেছে লিঙ্গ বিভাজন। আর এই বিভাজন আবহমান কাল থেকে তৈরি করেছে - সামাজিক বৈষম্য। যার ফলে সমাজের নারী মানুষের অধিকার থেকেই শুধু বঞ্চিত নয়, প্রাপ্তির ঘরও প্রায় শূন্য। নারী চিহ্নিত হয়েছে প্রান্তিক মানুষ হিসাবে। এমনকি নারীর মনও যেন এই বিভাজন মেনে নিতে প্রস্তুত। লিঙ্গ বৈষম্য শুধুমাত্র পুরুষ নারীর ভেদেই নয়, তৃতীয় লিঙ্গ আজও এই বৈষম্যের শিকার। নানা সময়ে বিভিন্ন আন্দোলন তৈরি হয়েছে এই অসাম্যকে নিয়ে, উঠে এসেছে নানা তত্ত্ব। সবটারই লক্ষ্য মানবতার ধারণা তৈরি করা।

সমাজের এই বৈষম্যের ধারণা সাহিত্যেও প্রতিফলিত। প্রাচীন সাহিত্যে যেমন মধ্যযুগের সাহিত্যে প্রান্তিকায়িত এই জীবন বহুবার উঠে এসেছে। এমন কি এই একুশ শতকে দাঁড়িয়েও সাহিত্য প্রতিবাদ প্রতিরোধ গড়েও সম্পূর্ণ মুক্ত নয় লিঙ্গ বৈষম্যের ধারণা থেকে। এই পণ্যায়নের যুগে আরো যেন প্রকট এই বিভাজন। কিন্তু আমরা চাই এমন এক পৃথিবী যা মুক্ত লিঙ্গ বৈষম্যের ধারণা থেকে। আমাদের আন্তর্জাতিক এই আলোচনাচক্রের আয়োজন এই স্বপ্ন ও প্রত্যাশা নিয়ে।

Gender is a fundamental social construct that shapes identities, roles, and power dynamics in society. It has been widely explored in literature, reflecting cultural norms, inequalities, and changing perspectives over time. This concept note examines gender from both a theoretical and factual perspective, highlighting its representation in society and literature. Gender is not purely biological but shaped by cultural, historical, and social forces. Judith Butler's Gender Trouble (1990) introduced the idea of gender performativity, where individuals "perform" gender roles based on societal expectations. Simone de Beauvoir's The Second Sex (1949) argues that women are historically defined as the "Other", while men are the normative standard. Gender is a social identity whereas sex is a biological identity and Virginia Woolf's A Room of One's Own (1929) emphasizes the need for economic and intellectual freedom for women. Traditional masculinity often emphasizes dominance, control, and rationality. Literature critiques toxic masculinity, as seen in Chinua Achebe's Things Fall Apart, where Okonkwo's rigid masculinity leads to his downfall. Queer and gender theory challenge the binary view of gender, advocating for fluidity and diverse identities. Virginia Woolf's Orlando and James Baldwin's Giovanni's Room explore non-traditional gender and sexuality perspectives. The study of gender in society and literature reveals evolving perceptions, struggles, and transformations. Literature serves as both a mirror and a tool-reflecting gender norms and challenging societal expectations. Understanding gender through both theoretical and factual lenses allows for a more nuanced appreciation of identity, equality, and representation in human history.
